Dear Prospective Leadership Candidate and Parents,

Thank you for your interest in applying to the ENHS Leadership Program. This program plays a significant role at ENHS and we are excited that you want to contribute to our community.

When applying for a position in Leadership, this year will be quite different than years previous. You will be submitting a video to Ms. Smith with the prompt, "What does leadership mean to you?" The video should be between 1-2 minutes long and shared over google documents. Keep in mind, the video **may** be shown over a virtual ballot, with all the student body having access to it. All positions require a significant number of hours of work during and outside of regular school hours.

Step One: Packet/Video Requirements

Your **fully completed** packet and video must be turned in by Friday, May 28 to Ms. Smith. No late packets will be accepted.

Step Two: Packet Evaluations

Based upon applications, videos, and positions held years previous. Students will be slated onto a ballot.

Step Three: Decisions

IF necessary (two/more students are exceptionally qualified for the same position), a virtual ballot will be generated and sent to all ENHS students.

- 1. All Student Body Officers must have been enrolled at East Nicolaus High School for five months prior to the time they run for office and should possess a current Student Body Card.
- 2. All Student Body officers must be enrolled in the Student Leadership class or another class appropriate for the duties of each office with approval of the ASB advisor.
- 3. To be eligible to run for a Student body office, students must be enrolled full time. They must possess at least a 2.0 GPA during the previous grading period. This average must be maintained during their term of office or a vacancy is created in that office.
- 4. Candidates must have good attendance and no discipline records. Candidates may only run for or hold one Student Council office during the school year.
- 5. All students of the student council and the Associated Student Body shall represent the school at other meetings as deemed necessary by student council.

Along with meeting these qualifications, all ASB members must commit to adhere to the East Nicolaus High School Leadership Code of Conduct as outlined on p. 12 of the application packet.

Finally, all ASB members must be available to work the following dates/events outside of the school day:

- Leadership Training Camp August 2021
- Freshman Camp August 2021
- Homecoming Week October 2021
- Courtwarming January/February 2022
- Community Appreciation Night April 2022
- Academic "E" Banquet May 2022
